Student/Athlete Code of Conduct

Our expectation is that all students will exhibit good sportsmanship and acceptable social attitudes in athletics whether practicing or in formal or informal competition. This means that you are expected to play by the rules, use your courage, control your strength, and remain appreciative, respectful, considerate, and honest with teammates, adversaries, coaches, and yourself.

We have created this code of conduct for you to read and sign so that we know that you have reviewed our expectations and are committed to good sportsmanship.

MMS Athletic Code of Conduct:

1. I follow the athletic rules and regulations. If I am unaware of the rules, it is my responsibility to let the coach know before I participate in a game.
2. I show respect for authority. I never talk back to an official, make faces, or exhibit physical or vocal gestures of disapproval. This is true when I am on the court, field, or on the bench.
3. I demonstrate good sportsmanship before, during, and after games. That means I do not cheer too loudly when we win, and I do not display outrage or self-directed anger if we lose. I understand that losing is an opportunity to learn more and winning comes from hard work during practice. I always make eye contact with every player at the end of the game.
4. I am courteous to opposing teams and treat all players with the utmost respect.
5. I am an ambassador of MMS, and I understand that my behavior tells the rest of the world what we are like as a school. I represent all of the students of the MMS community and hence, my comportment is very important to every child, parent, and faculty member of MMS.
6. I respect the privilege of using public facilities. I keep them clean.
7. I understand that the five school rules apply off of school grounds. As long as I am a student attending MMS, I respect and abide the five school rules.

Consequences of Misconduct:

Any failure to follow the MMS Athletic Code of Conduct will immediately result in the athlete being ejected from the game and may result in permanent suspension from future sports at the discretion of Milwaukee Montessori School faculty and administration.
